Grain Repeats

What is a repeat? A repeat refers to the number of inches it takes before a pattern starts all over again. The distance between a starting point and where that pattern begins again is referred to as "one repeat".

We consider the majority of our Ultrafabrics[®] collections as having random patterning, and are typically not matched when upholstered on average upholstery applications. However, in the instance of specifying vertical panels and wallcovering, this information is helpful in recognizing that there will be a degree of patterning repeated visibly throughout the large expanse.
